# Pullover Revival







## Intermediate

Sizes: S-M-L-XL

The smallest size is given first and largest sizes follow separated by a dash. Where only one figure is given, this applies to all sizes. Bust circumference: 88-92-96-100 cm (34  $^5\!\!\!/$  -36  $^1\!\!\!/$  -37  $^{13}\!\!/$  16 -39  $^3\!\!\!/$  "). Front/Back length: 56-58-60-62 cm (22  $^1\!\!\!/$  16 -22  $^{13}\!\!/$  16 -23  $^5\!\!\!/$  -

Inner sleeve length: 46-48-50-54 cm (18  $\frac{1}{8}$  -18  $\frac{7}{8}$  -19  $\frac{11}{16}$  - 21  $\frac{1}{4}$ ").

**Materials:** Adriafil New Zealand camel brown (92): 5-5-6-6 balls; 2 size 5 mm (6UK-8US) circular knitting needles (60 cm and 80 cm; 23 5/8 and 31 1/2"); 8 stitch markers (= SMs): 4 red and 4 yellow.

To substitute suggested yarn, you can use the following Adriafil yarns: New Zealand Print, Lana Naturale Inca.

# Patterns and stitches:

**1x1 ribbing in the round:** \*K1, P1, repeat from \* to end of round.

Mock English rib (number of sts divisible by 4):

**Round 1:** \*P1, K3, repeat from \* to end of round.

**Round 2:** \*P2, K1, P1, repeat from \* to end of round.

Always repeat Rounds 1-2.

**Tension:** 19 sts and 25 rows in mock English rib using size 5 mm needles = 10x10 cm (4x4").

Take time to check tension and change needles if necessary.

#### Directions:

**Note:** pattern is worked from neckline to hem in the round.

Using shorter size 5 mm circular knitting needle cast on 148-156-164-172 sts, join to work in the round and place a SM to mark beginning of round. Work in 1x1 ribbing in the round.

When work measures 8 cm (3  $\frac{1}{16}$ ), change to mock English rib as follows: work 44-48-52-56 sts (= Front), place 1 red SM, K1 (= 1st raglan), place 1 yellow SM, work 28 sts (= 1st Sleeve), place 1 red SM, K1 (= 2nd raglan), place 1 yellow SM, work 44-48-52-56 sts (= Back), place 1 red SM, K1 (= 3rd raglan), place 1 yellow SM, work 28 sts (= 2nd Sleeve), place 1 red SM, K1 (= 4th raglan), place 1 yellow SM.

Continue working as set, for raglans, on foll round increase 1 st before and after each raglan as follows: \*work in pattern to 1 st before red SM, work 2 sts in 1 st (= K1, P1), red SM, K1 (= raglan), yellow SM, work 2 sts in 1 st (= P1, K1), repeat from \* 3 more times (= 8 sts increased in the round).

Increase as given every other round 19 more times (= 308-316-324-332 sts).

**Note:** switch to longer circular needle when needed.

When work measures 27 cm (10  $\frac{5}{6}$  "), after last increase round, on foll round divide work as follows: work 84-88-92-96 sts (= Front), leave foll 70 sts on hold (= 1st Sleeve), work 84-88-92-96 sts (= Back), leave last 70 sts on hold (= 2nd Sleeve).

Work in mock English rib in the round over Front and Back sts (= 168-176-184-192 sts).

When work measures 48-50-52-54 cm (18 % -19  $^{11}$ /<sub>16</sub> -20  $\frac{1}{2}$  -21  $\frac{1}{4}$  "), work in 1x1 ribbing in the round.


When work measures 56-58-60-62 cm  $(22^{1}/_{16}-22^{13}/_{16}-23^{5}/_{8}-24^{7}/_{16})$  "), cast off all sts as they appear.

**Sleeves:** for each sleeve, place 70 held sts of Sleeve on the shortest circular knitting needle and, at the same time, decrease at each end working first 2 sts together and last 2 sts together (= 68 sts). Join to work in the round and place a SM to mark beginning of round. Work in mock English rib in the round.

When work measures 38-40-42-44 cm  $(14^{15}/_{16}-15^{3}/_{4}-16^{9}/_{16}-17^{5}/_{16})$  ") from pick-up line, for cuff, change to 1x1 ribbing decreasing 32 sts evenly across 1st round (= work 2 sts together in pattern) (= 36 sts). When work measures 46-48-50-54 cm  $(18^{1}/_{8}-18^{7}/_{6}-19^{11}/_{16}-21^{1}/_{4})$  from pick-up line, cast off all sts as they appear.

## Finishing:

Sew underarm holes.
