# Pullover Spiral



### Intermediate

Sizes: S-M-L-XL

The smallest size is given first and largest sizes follow separated by a dash. Where only one figure is given, this applies to all sizes.

Bust circumference: 100-104-108-112 cm (39  $\%-40^{15}/_{16}-42^{1/2}-44^{1/8}$ ").

Front/Back length: 53-55-58-60 cm (20 %-21 %-22 13/16-23 5%") (neckband not included).

Inner sleeve length: 38-38-39-39 cm (14  $^{15}/_{16}$  -14  $^{15}/_{16}$ -15  $^{3}/_{16}$ -15  $^{3}/_{16}$ ").

**Materials:** Adriafil Mistero (73): 7-7-8-8 balls; size 7 mm (2UK) circular knitting needle; 4 stitch markers (= SMs); cable needle.

## Patterns and stitches:

**Stocking stitch in rows:** knit on RS, purl on WS.

**Stocking stitch in the round:** knit all rounds.

Colonnade pattern A, in the round (number of sts divisible by 5): \*work 5 sts in stocking stitch for 9 rows, slip these 5 sts to cable needle, rotate cable needle clockwise (= to the right), then slip sts from cable needle to working needle, cut yarn. You have created a twisted column. Resume working on left-hand needle sts, repeat from \* to end of round.

Colonnade pattern B, in rows (number of sts divisible by 5): \*work 5 sts in stocking stitch for 9 rows, slip these 5 sts to cable needle, rotate cable needle clockwise (= to the right), then slip sts from cable needle to working needle, cut yarn. You have created a twisted column. Resume working on left-hand needle sts, repeat from \* to end of row.





**Tension:** 12 sts and 18 rows in stocking stitch using size 7 mm needles =  $10 \times 10$  cm ( $4 \times 4$ "); 12 sts and 22 rows in stocking stitch and colonnade pattern A/B using size 7 mm needles =  $10 \times 10$  cm ( $4 \times 4$ "). Take time to check tension and change needles if necessary.

### **Directions:**

**Front and Back:** pattern is worked in one piece in the round from hem to armholes.

Cast on 120-126-130-136 sts, join to work in the round and place a stitch marker (= SM) to mark beginning of round (= 1st side line). Place another SM at 60th-63rd-65th-68th st (= 2nd side line).


Work 4 rounds in stocking stitch, then purl 1 round (= fold round). Work 8 more rounds in stocking stitch, then work 1 stripe of colon-nade pattern A as follows:

- for size S only: work pattern repeat as given 24 times (= 24 twisted columns over 5 sts).
- for size M only: work pattern repeat as given 24 times, then work 1 pattern repeat over last 6 sts (= 24 twisted columns over 5 sts + 1 twisted column over 6 sts).
- **for size L only:** work pattern repeat as given 26 times (= 26 twisted columns over 5 sts).
- for size XL only: work pattern repeat as given 26 times, then work 1 pattern repeat over last 6 sts (= 26 twisted columns over 5 sts + 1 twisted column over 6 sts).

Change to stocking stitch over all sts and work as follows: 7 rounds in stocking stitch, 1 stripe of colonnade pattern A, 7 rounds in stocking stitch, 1 stripe of colonnade pattern A, end with stocking stitch.

When work measures 35-36-37-38 cm  $(13\frac{3}{4}-14\frac{3}{16}-14\frac{15}{16}^{-1})$ , for raglans, on next RS row work as follows: cast off 5 sts, work until 5 sts before next SM, cast off 10 sts, work to last 5 sts, cast off 5 sts (= 100-106-110-116 sts in total = 50-53-55-58 sts for Front and for Back).

Leave all remaining sts on hold.



**Sleeves:** cast on 42-42-47-47 sts and work 4 rows in stocking stitch beginning with 1 RS row, then purl 1 RS row (= fold row).

Work 8 rows in stocking stitch then work 1 stripe of colonnade pattern B setting up sts as follows: 1 st in stocking stitch, 8-8-9-9 twisted columns, 1 st in stocking stitch.

Then work 7 rows in stocking stitch over all sts increasing at each end 1 st on Row 3. Work increased sts into stocking stitch.

Work 1 stripe of colonnade pattern B setting up sts as follows: 2 sts in stocking stitch, 8-8-9-9 twisted columns, 2 sts in stocking stitch. Then work 7 rows in stocking stitch over all sts increasing at each end 1 st on Row 1 and on Row 5. Work increased sts into stocking stitch.

Work 1 stripe of colonnade pattern B setting up sts as follows: 4 sts in stocking stitch, 8-8-9-9 twisted columns, 4 sts in stocking stitch. Then work 7 rows in stocking stitch over all sts increasing at each end 1 st on Row 1 and on Row 5. Work increased sts into stocking stitch.

Work 1 stripe of colonnade pattern B setting up sts as follows:  $1 \, \text{st}$  in stocking stitch, 10-10-11-11 twisted columns,  $1 \, \text{st}$  in stocking stitch.

You have 52-52-57-57 sts.

Change to stocking stitch increasing at each end every other row 0-1-2-3 times 1 st (= 52-54-61-63 sts).

When work measures 38-38-39-39 cm ( $14^{15}/_{16}$ - $14^{15}/_{16}$ -15%-"), for raglans, on next RS row cast off 5 sts, work to last 5 sts, cast off 5 sts (= 42-44-51-53 sts). Leave remaining sts on hold.

**Yoke:** with RS facing place 50-53-55-58 held sts of Front on working needle, then place 42-44-51-53 held sts of 1st sleeve, 50-53-55-58 held sts of Back and 42-44-51-53 held sts of 2nd sleeve. Join to work in the round. Knit 1 round as follows: K49-K52-K54-K57, K2tog, mark resulting st for raglan, K40-K42-K49-K51, K2tog, mark resulting st for raglan, K48-K51-K53-K56, K2tog, mark resulting st for raglan, K40-K42-K49-K51, K2tog, mark resulting st for raglan (= 180-190-208-218 sts and 4 sts marked for raglans).

Change to stocking stitch in the round.

For raglans, decrease 1 st before and after each SM every other round 16-17-19-20 times (= 8 sts decreased in each decrease round = 52-54-56-58 sts).

After last decrease round (= work measures 53-55-58-60 cm;  $20\%-21\%-22^{13}/_{16}-23\%$ "), for neckband, work 8 more rounds in stocking stitch, then purl 1 round casting off sts.

# Finishing:

For hem, fold work to WS around fold round and sew loosely. For each cuff, fold work to WS along fold row and sew loosely.

Sew underarm seams.
