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## Intermediate

**Sizes:** S/M – L – XL

The smallest size is given first and largest sizes follow separated by a dash. Where only one figure is given, this applies to all sizes.

Bust circumference: 96-102-108 cm (37 <sup>13</sup>/<sub>16</sub>-40 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>16</sub>-42 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>”).

Front/Back length (measured from neckline to hem): 93-96-99 cm (36 <sup>5</sup>/<sub>8</sub>-37 <sup>13</sup>/<sub>16</sub>-38 <sup>31</sup>/<sub>32</sub>”).

Inner sleeve length: 51 cm (20 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>16</sub>”).

**Materials:** AdriaFil Matita (46): 7-7-8 balls; size 5 mm (6UK-H/8US) crochet hook; 4 stitch markers (= SMs).

### Patterns and stitches:

**Chain, slip stitch, double crochet, treble, double treble.**

**Triangle lace stitch:** work foll directions.

**Mesh stitch:** ch1 (counts as 1st dc throughout), \*ch3, skip 1 st, dc1 in next st, always repeat from \* to last st, ch3, ss1 in dc1.

**Tension:** 11 sts (= 3,5 triangles) and 4,5 rounds in triangle lace stitch using size 5 mm crochet hook = 10 x 10 cm (4 x 4”).

Take time to check tension and change hook if necessary.

### Directions:

**Note:** pattern is worked from neckline to hem in the round.

**Yoke:** chain 120, join in the round with ss1 in 1st ch.

**Round 1:** ch3 (counts as 1st tr), tr to end of round. Place 4 SMs as follows: 1st SM in 1st st (= beginning of Front), 2nd SM in 31st st (= end of Front / beginning of Right Sleeve), 3rd SM in 61st st (= end of Right Sleeve / beginning of Back), 4th SM in 91st st (= end of Back / beginning of Left Sleeve). Note: you have 30 sts for each part.

On next round start working in triangle lace stitch. Ch4 counts as 1st dtr throughout. Join with ss1 in top of beginning ch-4. At beginning of round, if necessary, ss across to next ch-sp.

**Round 2:** \*(dtr2, ch1 and dtr2) in same st (= 1 increase), skip 2 sts, \*\*dtr3 in next st, skip 2 sts (= triangle), repeat from \*\* 8 more times, repeat from \* 3 more times (= 1 increase and 9 triangles for each part).

**from Round 3 to Round 8-9-10:** \*(dtr3, ch1 and dtr3) in ch sp of previous round increase, 1 triangle in each foll ch sp, repeat from \* 3 more times (= 1 increase and 15-16-17 triangles for each part).

### Round 9-10-11 (= division round):

for Front: work triangles between 1st and 2nd SM BUT work ONLY 1 triangle in ch sp of previous round increase;

for Right Sleeve: skip triangles between 2nd and 3rd SM;

for Back: work 1 triangle in ch sp of increase below 3rd SM, work triangles between 3rd and 4th SM, work 1 triangle in ch sp of increase below 4th SM. **Note:** join with ss1 in top of beginning ch-4;

for Left Sleeve: skip triangles between 4th and 1st SM.

**Bodice and skirt:** to mark each side, place a SM in centre dtr of each side triangle. Work 13-14-15 triangle lace stitch rounds without increasing = 36-38-40 triangles in total.

**Round 14-15-16 (= increase round):** \*(dtr2, ch1 and dtr2) in marked dtr, work in triangle lace stitch until next marked dtr, repeat from \* once more.

Work 19 more rounds increasing at each side as given.

After working 33-34-35 rounds you have 74-76-78 triangles in total. Fasten off.

### Sleeves:

**Note:** choose two new balls with similar colour changes, use one for each sleeve working with inner end of yarn.

For each sleeve, join yarn with ss1 at underarm line. Work 1 triangle lace stitch round beginning with 1 increase at underarm line (= 16 triangles). Place a SM to mark beginning of round (= centre ch sp of underarm increase).

Work 7 triangle lace stitch rounds without increasing.

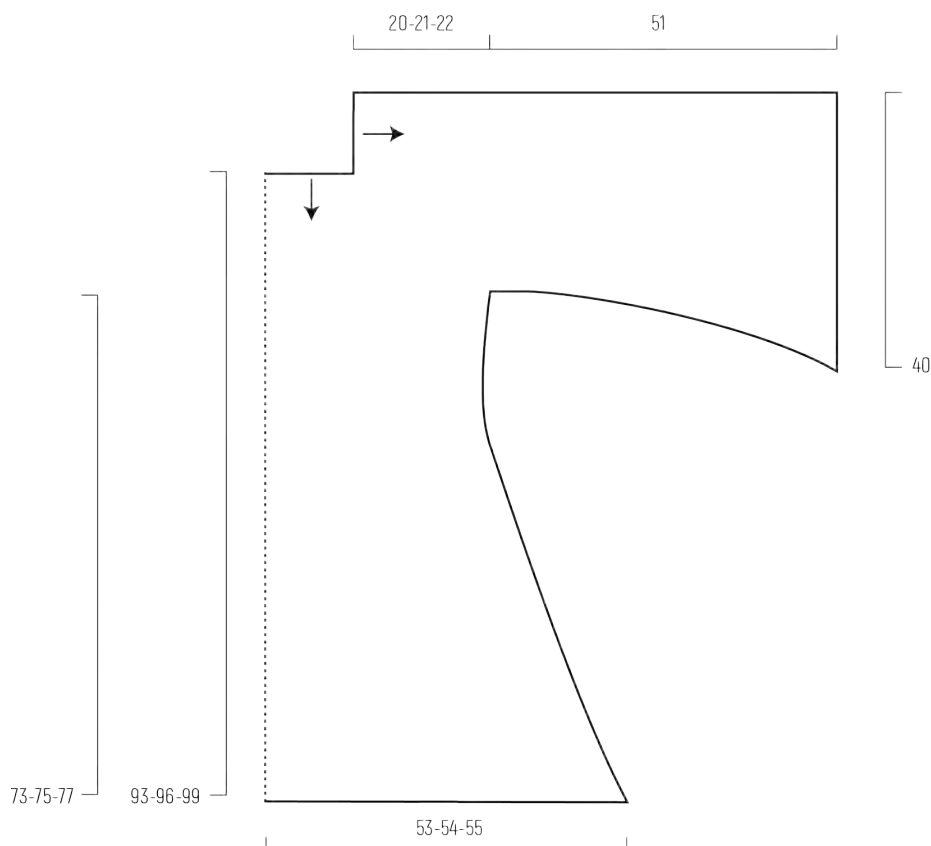
**Round 9 (= increase round):** (dtr3, ch1 and dtr3) in marked st, work in triangle lace stitch as given (= 1 increase and 16 triangles).

**from Round 10 to Round 23:** work in triangle lace stitch increasing in marked st as given (= 1 increase and 30 triangles).

At the end of Round 23, fasten off.

**Finishing:** for neckband, with RS facing join yarn with ss1 at any shoulder line and work 2 double crochet rounds as follows: ch1 (counts as 1st dc), dc to end of round, ss1 in 1st ch1.

Work 1 mesh stitch round, then fasten off.
